VACCINE POLICY

The physicians of Montgomery Pediatrics firmly believe in the effectiveness and safety of vaccines and require all children under our care to receive vaccinations according to the immunization schedule researched and established by the AAP.

We do not support alternative vaccine schedules or delaying vaccination. We firmly believe vaccines are necessary to prevent the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases, protect vulnerable individuals, and contribute to community immunity. All vaccines will be administered by trained healthcare professionals and vaccinations will be recorded in the patient's medical record. A record of vaccinations will also be reported to the state database (ImpactSIIS).

While we highly recommend vaccinating against influenza, Covid-19, and human papilloma virus (HPV), these vaccines are optional for patients. The RSV monoclonal antibody injection, Beyfortus, that is offered to infants under eight months old is also optional, but highly recommended.

Montgomery Pediatrics is committed to ensuring that all parents/guardians are fully informed about the benefits, risks, and safety of vaccines. Our physicians can and will provide educational materials, answer questions, and address any concerns that may arise regarding vaccines. If a parent/guardian refuses vaccinations, our physicians encourage open discussion to understand your concerns and to provide education regarding the importance of immunization. Refusal of vaccination outside of the optional vaccines and medical exemption will result in dismissal from Montgomery Pediatrics.
